MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR ADULTS, CHILDREN AND FAMILIES

As people across North Carolina continue to face challenges created by the coronavirus pandemic, Monarch’s mental health services are more important than ever. Increasing rates of depression, anxiety, substance use disorders and other mental health challenges mean that Monarch needs to be ready to provide support, whenever and wherever people need us. With tournament support, we are here and we can help.



CRISIS SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS

In late 2017, Monarch opened the SECU Youth Crisis Center, a Monarch program, in Charlotte. The Center is the first step in life-changing treatment for young people ages 6 to 17 that are experiencing a mental health crisis. This is the first center of its kind in North Carolina and will serve as a model for similar, much-needed programs across the state. Since it opened, the SECU Youth Crisis Center, a Monarch program has provided strong, clinically sound care to more than 1,300 emotionally fragile children and their families. Tournament support ensures these critical services are available to all kids and families, regardless of ability to pay.



CREATIVE COMMUNITY-BASED DAY PROGRAMS

Monarch’s Day Programs provide individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities a place where they have access to supportive services, life-skill-building and learning activities, social interaction and community involvement. Program participants engage in daily activities like pottery, art, nutrition and cooking, exercise and dance, community gardening, local volunteer service and adult basic education classes. The programs provide safe, engaging, community-focused opportunities for individuals with disabilities.
