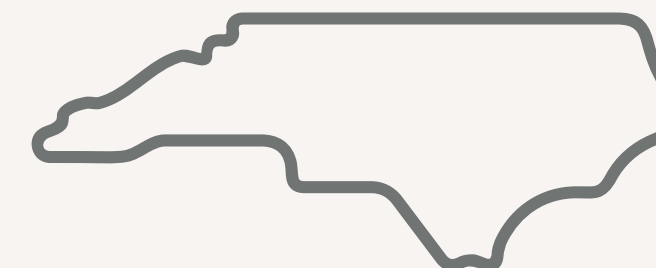

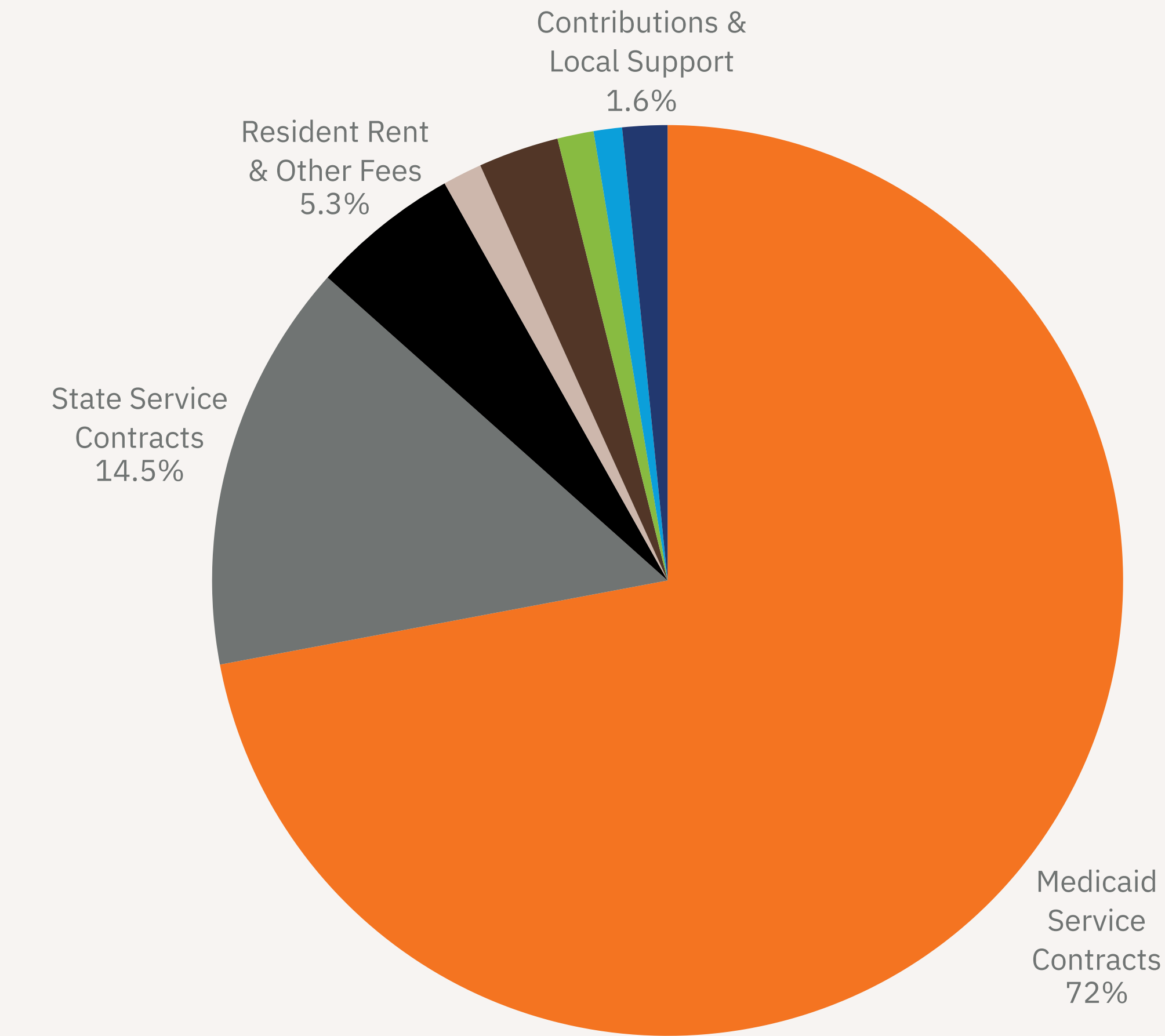

WALKING TOGETHER FOR AWARENESS

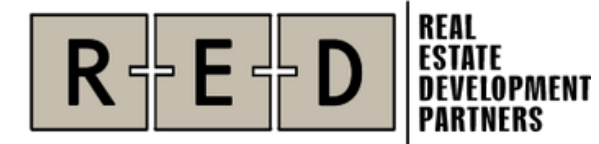
