Monarch Applications for Department of Transportation 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities

The Community Transportation Program helps coordinate existing transportation programs operating in the following counties as well as provides transportation options and services for the communities within these service areas.

The total estimated amount requested for the period July 1, 2027 through June 30, 2028 is \$597,049 in federal support (80%) and \$74,630 in state support (10%) with a required Monarch share of \$74,630 (10%). These projects total \$746,311.
